Equipment Needed

Urban Rifle

1. Eye and ear protection
2. Knee and elbow protection
3. A handgun and approximately 100 rounds for transitions
4. Have your rifle and at least six magazines. A sling for the rifle
5. A roll of white medical tape for fingers and hands etc.
6. If you are using a scope and it uses batteries bring extra batteries
7. Sunscreen
8. Clothes that will protect you from sun and hot brass
9. 1000 rounds of good ammo that you have tested in your rifle before class.

NO RELOADS

Defensive Handgun

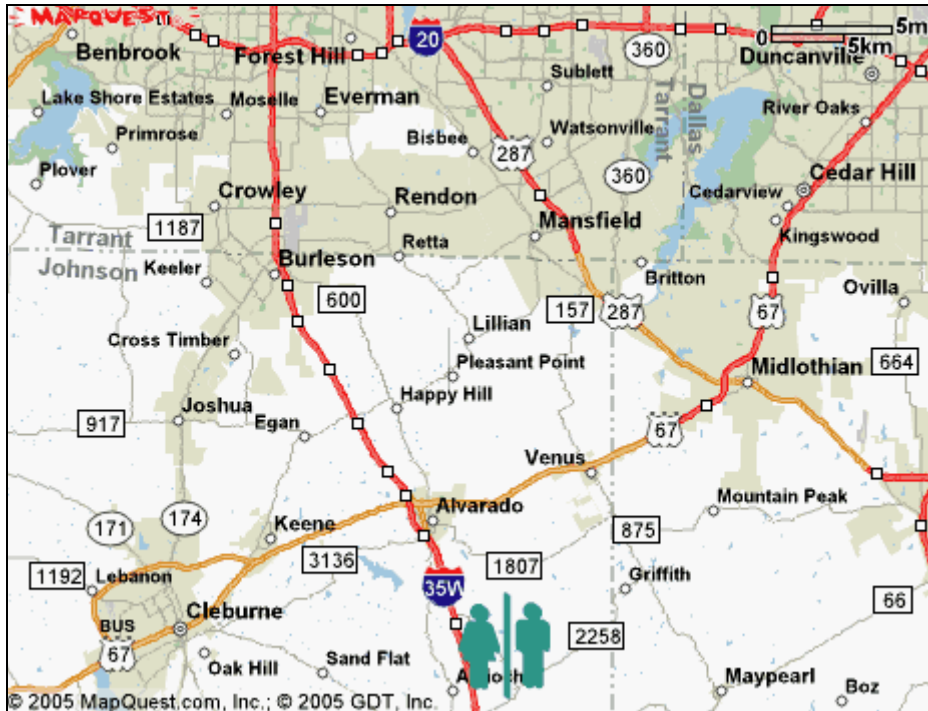
1. Eye and ear protection
2. Knee and elbow protection
3. A HANDGUN THAT WORKS. Bring a spare.
4. At least six magazines or speed loaders
5. 1000 rounds of good ammunition that you tested in your gun before you come to school

6. A GOOD holster, belt and magazine pouch
7. A roll of white medical tape for fingers, hands and sore spots
8. Sunscreen
9. Clothes that will protect you from sun and hot brass

I-35W Southbound

Take Exit 17. Continue on the service road south, turn left onto the overpass that crosses over the interstate. As you cross over the bridge you'll come to a stop. At this stop sign turn left onto the access road heading northbound, continue approx. 1/2 mile to TX CQB.

I-35W Northbound

Take Exit 17. Continue on the access road for about 1 mile until you see TX CQB.
